### **HOW DOES A TEAM BUILD DAY WORK?**

Team Build Days are unique opportunities for corporations and community groups to participate in a Habitat for Humanity build, and no experience is required! Whether your group is skilled in the construction field or have never swung a hammer before, being part of the Team Build Day program is for everyone.

Your day will start at 8:15 a.m. and we make sure everyone gets hardhats, work boots, a morning orientation, and most importantly - safety training.

Our construction staff will divide everyone up that day into task groups. Each task group will have a team lead, one of our experienced volunteers who will guide their crew that day. Each volunteer plays an important role. You could be sweeping floors, landscaping, building fences, putting up siding or painting. Every task we do is vitally important.

Habitat Homeowners, like Melissa and Detlef, fulfill their dreams of homeownership by volunteering 500 hours. You could be working right alongside a Future Homeowner!



Melissa and Detlef and their two sons Bruce and Clyde now call Wellesley home (our first rural build site). As homeowners, Melissa and Detlef are able to focus on their dream: to own a small organic farm that delivers fresh produce directly to their neighbour's doors.

Melissa lights up when she talks about their new neighbourhood – "there is a real spirit of welcome," and it is "humbling and inspiring to see the community support the building of our new home." Even Melissa's son, Bruce, has been impacted by Waterloo Region's awesome support, and has vowed to become an "inventor that builds things to help people."

Habitat for Humanity Waterloo Region envisions a world where everyone has a safe and affordable place to live.

Arrival: 8:15am (Coffee, light snack)


Orientation: 8:30am - 9:00am (Orientation/Safety Quiz)

- Everyone must register through the link provided by your Team Liaison registration instructions can be found on the next page of this document
- The build day starts with our mandatory safety orientation
  - •Late-comers risk being sent home
- Come dressed in layers for the weather long pants are required
- Bring a reusable water bottle
- If you are bringing your personal protective equipment (PPE), please ensure that you have a CLASS E, TYPE 2 hard hat and CSA approved, GREEN PATCH safety footwear. We have some onsite you can borrow, if needed, but if you have your own, please bring them!
- A 15-minute <u>safety video</u> **MUST** be watched before coming on site (see below) there will be a quiz done onsite, based on the video
- Please park at the Concordia Club the <u>parking pass</u> can be found at the end of this document (please print and put on your dashboard, you will avoid parking violations or having your vehicle towed). The walk from Concordia Club is less than 5 minutes.
